NV "Cuvée D", Devaux

12%, Bar-sur-Seine, Champagne

With a gold yellow colour, Cuvée D has a delicate and persistent mousse. White blossom and soft spices appear first on the nose, mellowed by notes of toasted brioche and vanilla on the finish. Cuvée D presents freshness with mandarin and orange zest notes. It offers a deliciously fresh and creamy champagne of great intensity.

2019 Chenin Blanc, Aloe Tree

13%, Western Cape, South Africa

Aromatic guava and orange blossom jump from the glass – this Chenin Blanc is dry with hint of sweetness from the ripe apples, peaches and a hint of orange peel on the palate.

2018 Sauvignon Blanc, Trinity Hill

12%, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay Sauvignon Blanc A beautiful Hawkes Bay Sauvignon Blanc with gentle aromas of lime, citrus and lemongrass complemented by stone fruit. Fuller-bodied than a Marlborough, it combines freshness and complexity.

2019 Gavi, Tenuta Olim Bauda

12.5%, Piedmont, Italy

Fine bouquet with nice intensity and persistence, offering slightly floral notes, with a fresh, graceful and well-structured palate.

2017 Riesling GC "Saering", Domaine Schlumberger

14%, Alsace, France

Crisp and dry, intensely mineral Riesling with bright citrus notes of tangerine, candied lemon and white peach followed by fragrant floral notes of jasmine, honeysuckle and white tea.

2018 Chablis, Domaine Bernard Defaix

12.5%, Burgundy, France

Fresh and lively Chablis with fresh green apple, green pear, lemon zest and crème fraîche on the nose. Dry and mineral on the palate with long finish.

2017 Soave "Calvarino", Pieropan

12.5%, Veneto, Italy

Fresh, floral aromas of elderflower, lemon and cherry; the palate is dry, well balanced and elegant, with tremendous length and finesse.

NV Alandes, 'Paradoux' White Blend, Bodega Altocedro,

13.5%, Mendoza, Argentina

A blend of Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc, this wine offers generous aromas on the nose with hints of candied lemon, lemon verbena, ripe peaches and a touch of vanilla. The palate is dry with creamy texture and long finish.

2017 Sonoma Coast Chardonnay, Crossbarn Paul Hobbs

14.5%, California, USA

Glistening straw yellow with a faint green hue and fragrant aromas of white flower, Asian pear, and wet stone underpin the wine's expression of its true Sonoma Coast roots. Alluring stone fruit flavours carry the palate along with hints of citrus and honeysuckle that evolve into a creamy mid-palate before ending in a long, clean finish with crisp acidity.

2017 "Vistamare", Ca'Marcanda

14%, Tuscany, Italy

Intense floral notes of acacia and linden flowers. The refreshing presence of Fiano gives notes of fern, musk and menthol. On the palate, it is fresh and compact with notes of bergamot, pear, nectarine and white currant.

Rosé wine

2019 Rosé, Château la Tour de l'Évêque

13.5%, Provence, France

Light, pale pink coloured rosé, with aromas of wild strawberries, clementine peel, peach and nectarine. Dry and refreshing this is a perfect summer treat.

Red wine

2018 "Rosso Terre Siciliane", Il Barroccio

£30.00/ £6.00

13%, Sicily, Italy

Il Barroccio red comes from the sunny, warm Sicily, in Italy. It is made of Nero d'Avola grapes, an indigenous grape variety. It bursts with aromas of ripe dark cherries and warm spices. It has soft tannins and juicy dark fruits on the palate.

2018 Cabernet Sauvignon "Gran Reserva", Nostros

13.5%, Maipo Valley, Chile

Bright red black in colour. Delicate and fruity, with notes of prune, dried cherry, figs, and dried peach. Lovely grassy character, medium body, deliciously velvety, and delicate with soft tannins.

2017 Syrah, Trinity Hill

12.5%, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

This Syrah has aromas of wild raspberry, blueberry, cracked pepper and hints of vanilla bean on the nose. Powerful, ripe tannins give the wine great structure. Oak plays a supporting role to the wine's pure fruit expression.

2018 Fleurie "Grand-Pré", Lathulière Gravallon £45.00/ £9.00

13%, Beaujolais, France

Pure and fresh, this Fleurie shows juicy cherry and wild forest berry fruit combined with potpourri and pink peppercorn notes. Delicate but impressive structure.

2016 "Coyam", Viñedos Emiliana £56.00/ £11.50

14.5%, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Dark-fruit aromas of this Syrah-led blend are pure and come with a slight floral note. A saturated palate is packed to the gills with ripe intensity, with tastes of blackberry, toast and molasses. Toasty oak notes on the finish.

2016 Bolgheri, Poggio al Tesoro 'Il Seggio' £73.00/ £15.00

14.5%, Tuscany, Italy

This wine is intense ruby red in colour with aromas of fresh crunchy red berries enriched with mineral and spicy notes. The red fruit follows onto the palate which is medium bodied with elegant silky tannins and a lively clean finish.

2018 Malbec, "Sunal" Salvaje, Agustin Lanus £80.00/ £16.00

14.5%, Salta, Argentina

Big bold and fresh red wine, with ripe black and blue berry notes, violet, leather and a hint of black pepper. Dry on the palate with ripe plush tannins and long juicy finish.

2015 Gevrey-Chambertin, Vallet Frères £95.00/ £19.00

13%, Burgundy, France

Delicate sweet strawberry fruit, fresh acidity and a clean, vibrant palate. A restrained style, with elegance and a savoury, autumnal finish.

2012 Rioja Gran Reserva, Marqués de Murieta £97.00/ £20.00

13%, Rioja, Spain

Open and complex nose full of exotic sweet spices, dark cherry and sweet Asian plum followed by notes of sweet tobacco and leather. Soft, silky tannin and long and persistent finish.

2013 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOCG, Prà £116.00/ £22.00

16.5%, Veneto, Italy

A ripe, open and spicy nose with aromas of wild cherry, plums and dried herbs. Firm, ripe tannins on the palate lead to flavours of bitter cherry, spice and tarry, liquorice notes too. The finish is complex and long, further opening to reveal dried orange peel, and ripe red fruit characters backed by a hint of mocha.

Sweet wine

2015 Lions de Sudiraut, Château Sudiraut, Bordeaux, France

£58.00/ £12.00

Brilliant golden colour with aroma of ripe nectarines, peach, orange marmalade, saffron and honey. Rich and full bodied with fresh zesty acidity balancing the generous sweetness and long lingering finish.
